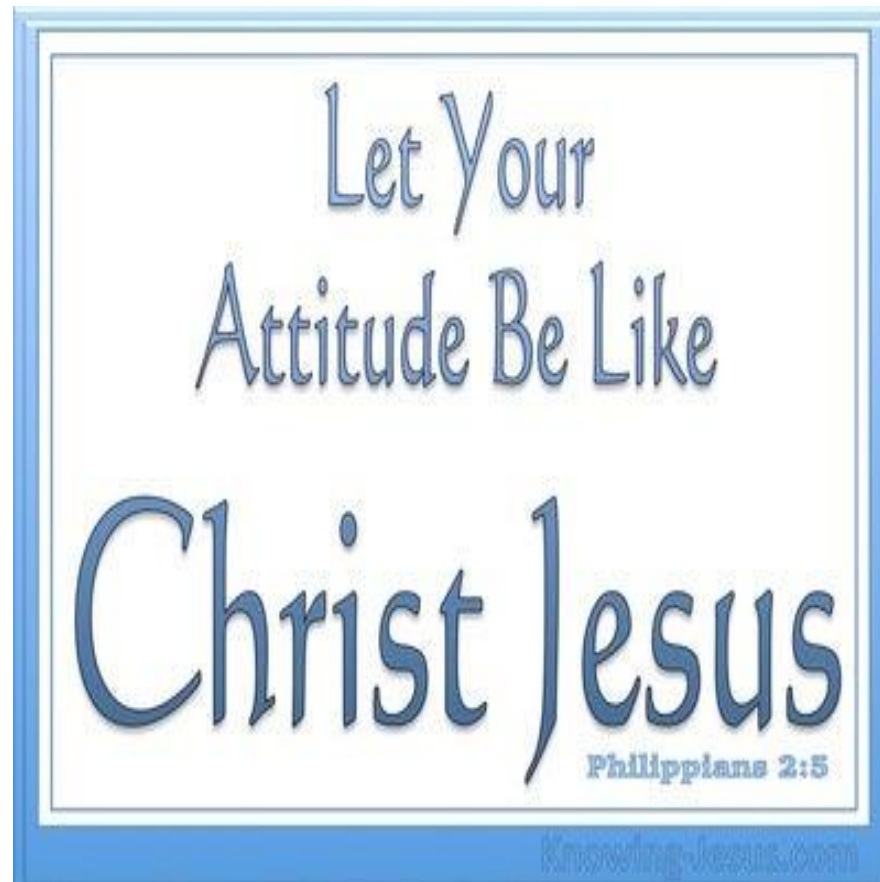

August 21, 2023

Treasurer's Report-Susan reported that the savings account balance is \$9,921 and the checking account balance is \$6,637. The finance committee will be meeting soon, to set up the budget for the upcoming year.

Deacons-Rick reported that they have helped with serving communion. The deacons will be doing a pastor evaluation with Pastor Stuart. The evaluation form used, comes from the Central District Conference.

Christian Education-Marla reported that Sunday School Teachers for the new year are in place. The digital curriculum that is being used for the Jr Department is from Lifeway. Susan reported that Lifeway recently raised their price. Pastor Stuart & committee will look into other options. The Christmas program is scheduled for December 10. Marla has been in touch with the Dean Sikes Ministry. He will be coming to the area to share with Jr/Sr High kids that there is hope and that you matter. Hopefully he will be able to give assemblies with each school in the area. There is no cost to the church for this.

Trustees- Skylar reported they are looking into purchasing audio-visual equipment so the quality of the Sunday morning broadcast will be improved. There is a dead tree in the cemetery that needs to be removed.
