Mike Laughlin, 69, died on Mon., Oct. 9, 2023, in a kayaking accident near his home in Boise, Idaho. Mike was the husband of Belva (Wollman) for 29 years, who grew up in Freeman, graduating from Freeman Academy in 1969.

On the afternoon of October 9, Mike and Belva, who were experienced kayakers, took their kayaks out on the Boise River. A fallen tree and swift currents caused both kayakers to capsize. Mike was unexpectedly trapped under a tangle of branches and logs and the Lord took him home.
