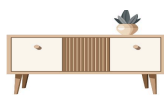

Only 50% of foster families last more than a year & only 8% make it past the 5 year mark. Lack of social support is the #1 cause of burnout.

THE SECRET WEAPON: WRAP-AROUND SUPPORT



- Painting and prepping a bedroom in a new foster parent's home
- Buying clothes to hang in the child's room for when they first arrive
- Orchestrating a meal train for a family when they get a placement
- Mowing a family's lawn after a hard week
- Babysitting a foster family's children so foster parents can bond with a newly placed child
- Taking a newly placed child on a fun outing to give foster parents a break
- Doing laundry, cleaning the house, spending time praying and more!
