A WORD TO OUR CHURCH FAMILY

As we step into a new year together, I've been thinking a lot about what it means to be a church. Not just a place we go, but a people we belong to. A group of ordinary people trying to be faithful in ordinary ways, trusting God to do extraordinary things through it.

We've always been a church that shows up. You show up to worship. You show up to serve. You show up for each other in hard moments and good ones. That matters more than you probably realize.

Part of walking together also means being open about where we are. Right now, our giving has been a little behind where it needs to be. We are about \$5,000 short, it is something we need to pay attention to as its a real shortfall
